Page 6/Item #7 Performance Bond: In my 3 decades of furnishing OPM Services, I
have not furnished a Performance Bond for Professional Services. Could you revisit?

We do not require a performance bond for either the OPM or Commissioning Agent. We will address concerns in the contract regarding performance.

 Page 7/ Items #11 Retainage: Also, in my 3 decades of furnishing OPM Services, My Contracts for Professional Services never included retainage. Could you revisit? A retainage will increase the Hourly Rate.

No Retainange in required, but payment terms will be addressed in the contract.

3. Page 7/ Items #14 Term of Contract: Paragraph reads for 13 weeks. Isn't it the intention for 13 months of Professional Oversight?

You are correct that the 13 weeks should read as a minimum of 13 months based on projected time periods and projected completion.

4. At the Bid Opening, are you going to open up the Qualifications and Fee Envelopes? My experience is that only the Qualification Envelope is read publicly. Please clarify?

Yes, we will open both the qualifications envelope as well as the fee envelope. We will post fee schedules but not qualifications.

5. My firm intends to submit on both RFP's since we provide both OPM and Commissioning services, and we feel that we could provide a cost savings to Columbia by offering an efficiency of a hybrid role or at least a combined team to tackle both tasks. Formal question: Would a single firm be eligible to be selected for both the Commissioning Agent and Owner's Project Management position(s)?

We would allow the same firm to make proposals for both the OPM and the Commissioning Agent or as a combined proposal as long as the qualifications for both services are met. Please note on the outside envelope that it is a combined bid.

6. We are interested in responding to your commissioning RFQ. I noticed that there is a mandatory pre-submission meeting on May 23 at 10 am and I didn't see any information regarding registering for the meeting and if it would be held virtually or not. Any information that you could share with me would be greatly appreciated.
